Sustainable and Smart Mobility Strategy

EU has worked on drones since 2015

Regulatory Framework now in place:

- Technical requirements for drones
- Requirements for drone operations and for drone operators
- U-Space regulatory framework

A new Drone Strategy 2.0 is being developed based on a wide consultation

Some priorities for the Drone Strategy 2.0

- **Content of the Strategy to be based on outcome of widespread consultation and the Report of the Drone Leaders' Group**
- **Priorities for IAM (but not only) including: Aerial Services, Urban Air Mobility, Public acceptance and Infrastructure (Vertiports and U-space)**
- **The Drone Strategy will contain:**
 - **A vision for the drone sector in 2030**
 - **Action areas with concrete proposals to:**
 - + Support the development of the European drone services market and
 - + Strengthen European industry capabilities including by reaping synergies between civil and military sectors
- **SAFIR MED project fully in line with Drone Strategy 2.0 priorities**
- **The Drone Strategy will be delivered in Q4 2022**
